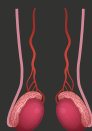
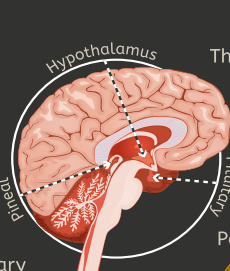

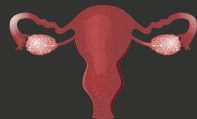

### REGISTRATION
