- Create an algorithm for complex endovascular management of peripheral vascular ischemia.

Invited Speakers



Francis Caputo, MD is the Vascular Surgery Director of the Aorta Center, Program Director of the Vascular Surgery Training Program and staff vascular surgeon in the Sydell and Arnold Miller Family Heart, Vascular & Thoracic Institute. He is also an Associate Professor of Surgery at the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine of Case Western Reserve University. His clinical specialties include complex open and endovascular repair of thoracic, thoracoabdominal, and abdominal aortic aneurysms; as well as the open repair of failed endografts.

Dr. Caputo is the national principal investigator of two trials investigating endovascular repair of complex aneurysms as well as non-radiation-based imaging for aortic repair. His research interest is in clinical outcomes in vascular surgery, particularly the role of regionalized care. He has authored or co-authored over 80 papers in leading medical and surgical journals and has contributed chapters to 10 medical textbooks.



Suresh Vedantham, MD is an experienced Interventional Radiologist who specializes in the delivery and clinical investigation of image-guided therapies for venous thromboembolism (VTE). He is a Professor of Radiology & Surgery, Assistant Dean for Clinical Research at the Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, MO and Founder-Director of its Trial-CARE Center that focuses on multicenter clinical trial innovation Mallinckrodt Institute of Radiology.

Dr. Vedantham played a central role in refining innovative IR treatments for venous disease and devoted his career to developing high-quality evidence to guide venous care. In 2008, he was publicly thanked by the U.S. Surgeon General for his leadership in bringing together diverse stakeholders around VTE awareness. The recipient of more than \$30 million in grant funding, Dr. Vedantham serves as National Principal Investigator (PI) of the landmark NIH-sponsored ATTRACT and C-TRACT Trials and as National Co-PI of the NIH-sponsored PE-TRACT Trial that are defining the optimal role of catheter-based therapy in the management of VTE. He served as the 2017-2018 President of the Society of Interventional Radiology (SIR) and to have received SIR's 2024 Leader in Innovation Award. He will start his term as Secretary of the SIR Foundation in March 2025, progressing to Chair over the next 2 years.




